# 3. ILLICIT DISCHARGE DECTCTION AND ELIMINATION

Storm Water system mapping

Kane County staff also continued to update the County's storm sewer mapping Throughout the unincorporated areas of the County. As of March 2017, More than 63 miles of storm sewers, culverts, roadside ditches, channels, and drain tiles have been added to the mapping system. Detention basins Have also been included. To date, 418 detention basins in unincorporated Kane County have been identified and mapped. This represents approximately 90% of all stormwater detention basins within Unincorporated Kane County.

### OTHER ILLICIT DISCHARGE CONTROLS

Storm Drain System Cleaning:
