1. **CHANGES TO BEST MANagements PRACTICES**

2. **PUBLIC EDUCATION AND OUTREACH**

Campton Township will utilize existing and proposed involvement and participation by Kane County Department of Environment and Water Resources as part of Kane County's NPDES Phase II NOI. The following existing township program addresses part of this control measure.

Public Meetings

Campton Township conducts monthly meetings, 2nd Tuesdays of each month. Citizen's comments are welcomed. Annual meeting conducted yearly.

Public Education

The Township will continue to utilize the existing and proposed education and outreach programs that are administered by the Kane County Department of Environmental and Water Resources and updated on the "Stormwater Education" page on the County Website.

3. **ILLCIT DISCHARGE DETECTION AND ELIMINATION**

Stormwater System Mapping

During the permit year, the Kane County Division of Environment & Water Resources continued to update the County storm sewer mapping throughout the unincorporated areas of Kane County. Storm sewers, culverts, roadside ditches, channels, and drain tiles have been added to the mapping system.

OTHER ILLICIT DISCHARGE CONTROLS

- a) Campton Township adopted the same procedures/system that Kane County employees use to detect and eliminate illicit discharge.
- b) Storm Water Permit Program MS4 Permit
- c) Septic care brochures are still available to homeowners and that utilize a septic system.

4. **CONSTRUCTION SITE RUNOFF**

Kane County Storm Water Management Ordinance:

Construction site stormwater run-off within Campton Township is regulated by the Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance which was adopted by the Kane County Board. The Ordinance is enforced in unincorporated areas and non-certified communities within Campton Township by the Kane County Water Resources Department.

5. **POST CONSTRUCTION SITE RUNOFF:**

Kane County Stormwater Ordinance:

Post-construction stormwater management in new development and redevelopment areas within Campton Township is regulated by Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance which was adopted by the Kane County Board. The Ordinance is enforced in unincorporated areas and non-certified communities within Campton Township by the Kane County Water Resources Department.

6. POLLUTION PREVENTION / GOOD HOUSEKEEPING:

Employee Training Program

Employee Pollution Prevention Training Program

- a) Annual training programs through Kane County to enhance the understanding of and potential for implementation of storm water Best Management Practices
- b) On site staff training for reporting, record keeping, & enforcement

Inspection and Maintenance Program

Storm Drain System Cleaning:

- a) Campton Township's Operation and Maintenance Program for MS4:
 - Roadside swales are cleared of debris and garbage once a week.
- b) Catch basins and storm inlets in the Campton Township Highway Department facility are inspected and cleaned quarterly by staff.
- c) Material Storage
- d) Proper hazardous waste disposal
- e) Roadside ditch maintenance
- f) Vehicle washing
- g) Salt Application and Storage
