Agreement between Campton Township Highway District and Village of Campton Hills to Expire

The Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the Campton Township Highway District and the Village of Campton Hills is expiring July 31, 2022. The IGA has been in place since the Village incorporated in 2007 and has served both the Highway District and Village residents well.

The Campton Township Highway District and the Village have not been able to reach an agreement to renew the expiring IGA. Accordingly, the Village of Campton Hills will be taking over the maintenance and servicing the Village streets and roadways effective August 1, 2022.

Whereas the Campton Township Highway District would have liked to continue with the existing agreement, Village President Mike Tyrrell after two months of talks, has broken off negotiations. It is unfortunate this change is taking place at the 11th hour.

After expiration of the IGA, the Highway District will continue to receive over one-half million dollars of the Township Road and Bridge Fund generated within the Campton Township portion of the Village to maintain unincorporated roads which funds were previously used by the district to maintain Village roads.

The Campton Township Highway District would like to thank the Village for their past cooperation and wish the best to the Village as they take total control and responsibility for the maintenance of the Village streets and roads.

The 2017 IGA expired on June 1, 2022, and the Campton Township Highway District gave two 30-day extensions to the Village with the last extension expiring on 7-31-22.

Although the Township Highway District will no longer be servicing and maintaining the Village roadways, all services to streets and roads in unincorporated Campton Township will continue without interruption.
